Report on the use and process of emergency financial aid funds

On March 2021 President Biden signed a new emergency plan known as the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARP) (Pub. L. 117-2) which grants new relief funds to active students during the emergency of Covid-19. In compliance of the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF III), the PRSNA have disclosure the use of funds. In our institution, these funds were used 100% for students as emergency aid for expenses related to the coronavirus under ARP (a)(4).

Within the reporting and grant distribution process, the Puerto Rico School of Nurses Anesthetists (Professional University Dr. Carlos J. Borrero Ríos now), notifies the student community that the institution received the amount of \$ 9,078.00, which was distributed among students enrolled in Fall 2021 semester, have completed the Free Application for Federal Student Aid also known as FAFSA and comply the standards of the Satisfactory Academic Progress. This emergency relief fund impacted about 103 students for \$ 88.13 per each and the determination of eligibility was made in accordance with both federal and institutional policies also considering as a priority the needs of the students.

Please note that this report is an update of the funds distributed in September 2021 and of which there are no changes as of the date this communication is generated.
